Fairbury City Park

The Fairbury City park is host to the largest flea market in Nebraska, the Fourth of July Flea Market. Each year during the July 4th holiday, thousands of visitors come to the Fairbury City Park to shop the hundreds of vendors displaying their goods.

It also home to the Fairbury Softball Complex, Legion Baseball Field, Fairbury Waterpark, Fairbury Storywalk®, and the wooden play area named Fairbury's Frontier Funpark.

The design of the wooden playground came from community children. In 1995, design elements kids drew were incorporated into the final playground plan. The theme is "Old West," reflected in the building material and multiple features. It was funded by community donations and built with more than 2,300 volunteers putting in more than 17,500 hours in five days.
