He even comes in early to make sure all residents are cared for. He is the first to volunteer to take on extra tasks, such as transporting residents to appointments outside the facility. One resident really longed for a ride in his black Cadillac – so he brought it to work, got the proper permissions, and took the resident for a ride. The resident's smile said it all. He also takes time to make sure each resident feels special – singing "You are my Sunshine" to them when he is with them. Whenever Wayne is around, giggles and smiles are sure to follow! Many residents and staff lovingly call him "Mr. Wonderful" for how amazing he is as a CNA, activities coordinator and all-around person.

CDC and CMS have recently adapted new guidelines for screening and masking. We are reviewing all CDC and CMS regulations, and will be diligent in making the best possible decisions for our residents and staff. As of the printing of this newsletter, we awaiting further guidance from the state and the ICAP group we have received guidance from throughout the pandemic.

Our county's COVID numbers, specifically our transmission rate, will continue to be a part of what guides us.

Visitors will continue to use Door 31. Door 31 is now unlocked from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Once inside the breezeway, visitors must screen at the kiosk, and then use the doorbell on the west wall to let staff know you are ready to visit. Staff will then allow you entrance to the Gardenside door.

Residents are allowed to go out of the facility for outings with family. We encourage them to avoid large gatherings. Staff appreciates a 24-hour notice to ensure proper paperwork is completed. Please call 402-729 -5220 Monday through Friday to schedule outings.
