Gardenside Has Excellent State Survey

Gardenside had its annual Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services survey in January and we are proud to report no deficiencies in nursing. We did have 3 small deficiencies from the State Fire Marshal, but those have all been fixed.

The survey team commended the staff on the excellent care they are providing, as the survey team observed the residents to be happy and well cared for. They also commended the management team on how well they ensured and followed infection control practices to keep COVID-19 exposure low.

Gardenside is extremely proud to remain a remain a 5 star facility.

I can say from all the staff that we care for your loved ones like they are family. Thank you for choosing Gardenside.

Current COVID and Masking Guidelines

Facility policy allows us to follow CDC and CMS guidance and not require masking of our visitors or staff WHEN JEFFERSON COUNTY IS NOT IN THE "RED" according to CMS designations. When we are in the red masking is required. As of the publication of this newsletter Jefferson County is in the yellow, so visitors are not currently required to mask.

Signage at all of our entrances shows what "designation" our county is in, and whether masking is required or not. Typically these designation changes come early on Friday mornings. If you would like to check out our county's color before visiting, you may visit <u>CDC COVID Data Tracker: Home</u>. Select Jefferson County, NE, and then for Data type go to Community Transmission. This color may be different then the "COVID-19 Community Level" (which is designed to inform community members of how they should be protecting themselves.) **Please note healthcare facilities are required to use the Community Transmission designation for guidance. We check this map for our County Transmission Color every Friday to guide our masking requirements.**

To ensure the safety and well-being of our residents and staff we take COVID precautions very seriously and if families do not abide by the core principles of infection control, they will be asked to leave and not allowed to visit until further notice.

Visitors may use Door 31 or the JCH&L main entrance and the hallway door to Gardenside. Door 31 is now unlocked from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. The JCH&L main entrance is open the hours that the fitness center is open.




