Help us help Pearl


Pearl has been to obedience boot camp, and has learned a number of very important things. This means we all have to learn some important things, as well, so we are consistent with her continued training and obedience.

We ask family members and visitors to help us reinforce Pearl's behavior with some hand signals:

- *If she jumps, please point down with one finger and say down.
- *To ask her to sit, say sit and hold your hand palm up, bent down.
- *To ask her to stay, say stay and hold your hand up with fingers up—palm facing Pearl. (Like you might use to signal "stop.")
- *To get her to come to you, hold your hand at your waist and wave your fingers toward you and say come.

If you have trouble, please ask a staff member for guidance. We are all learning together!
